(Somerville, MA) **HONK! Festival 2024** has just revealed their participating bands roster for this year's **19th annual gathering of activist street musicians**. Current count is at 29+ unplugged mobile bands, several who will travel some distance... as far away as Brazil, as well as from NOLA, Minneapolis (MN), NYC & Brooklyn (NY), Pittsburgh (PA), Austin (TX), Olympia & Seattle (WA), Madison (WI). With much representation from New England-based groups, HONK! 2024 will swell to a capacity of at least 29 bands, with several of those bands being as large as 30 or more players, all performing unplugged right on the streets of Davis and Harvard Squares.

For those who are not familiar, HONK! is an annual uproariously jubilant purposeful gathering held every October since 2006. The entire Festival is inspired by a commitment to social change through music, embodied in the powerful upbeat sounds generated by activist street bands who have traveled from near and far to participate in this particular annual HONK! Because, after all, this is where the HONK! movement all started, spawning many a HONK! elsewhere since then. HONK! 2024 will follow the familiar tried and true scheduling patterns, with **outdoor street level band concerts** held throughout Somerville's Davis Square and the nearby neighborhoods on HONK! Friday and Saturday. Then on to the vast "**Reclaim the Streets for Horns, Bikes, and Feet**" **Parade,** as it wends its way from Davis Square to Harvard Square in Cambridge, on HONK! Sunday, to participate in Harvard Square's 45th annual **Oktoberfest**. But every year there are also the HONK! surprise(ing) elements, often reflecting the signs of our particular given times.
